Thesis Defense Ceremony at Tehran University of Medical Sciences (TUMS) Held with Research Collaboration from Six Countries

The thesis defense of Zhina Amjadi, a General Dentistry student at TUMS, took place on February 12, 2025.

Her thesis, titled "Comparison of Demographic, Clinical, and Histopathological Characteristics of Premalignant Lesions of the Oral Cavity among International Diagnostic Centers of Oral Pathology (2010–2022) in Six Countries," was carried out in collaboration with Iranian and international professors from six countries and nine academic and research institutions.

Dr. Nazanin Mahdavi and Dr. Shiva Shirazian from the Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Diseases served as thesis advisors, working alongside consulting professors from Iran, India, Turkey, Malaysia, Pakistan, and Thailand in conducting and developing the research.

Short-Term Training Courses by Iran University of Medical Sciences Launched in Georgia Using Private Sector Capabilities



As part of ongoing internationalization efforts and the expansion of knowledge-sharing with neighboring countries, a collaboration agreement has been established with Iranian private sector representatives in Georgia.

This initiative adheres to Georgia's educational laws and aligns with international higher education regulations. These courses aim to strengthen scientific collaboration, promote knowledge exchange, and create educational opportunities for students and professionals across various medical science disciplines in Georgia.

Under the agreement, the private sector will fully cover investment costs, while the university will provide scientific support and faculty for the short-term courses. Further details on the admission process and course offerings will be announced soon on the university's official website.



Mazandaran University of Medical Sciences has welcomed new international students for the 2024–2025 academic year.

Dr. Mohsen Ramezani, Director of International Affairs at Mazandaran University of Medical Sciences, emphasized the university's commitment to advancing internationalization and improving its global standing. He announced the completion of the fifth round of international student registrations, welcoming students from Pakistan, India, Afghanistan, and Iraq. The registration process was conducted at the Payambar Azam Academic Complex.

The newly admitted students have enrolled in a range of disciplines, including General Surgery, Dentistry, Toxicology, Parasitology, and Virology. Additionally, students have been admitted to master's programs in MBBS, Toxicology, Clinical Biochemistry, Microbiology, Immunology, Emergency Nursing, Critical Care Nursing, and Psychiatric Nursing.

Mazandaran University of Medical Sciences currently hosts 165 international students. With this new intake, the total number of international students has risen to 251.

Shiraz University of Medical Sciences Showcases Medical Excellence at Health Tourism Exhibition in Tehran



Shiraz University of Medical Sciences (SUMS) participated in the Health Tourism Exhibition in Tehran from February 11–14, 2025. The university hosted a booth highlighting Shiraz's advancements in medicine and healthcare, drawing interest from both domestic and international stakeholders.

Representatives from various private healthcare centers, including Abu Ali Sina Transplant Hospital, Kowsar Hospital, Shiraz Central Hospital, and Ordibehesht Hospital, joined SUMS officials from the Health Tourism Unit.

Throughout the four-day exhibition, the SUMS health tourism team held constructive discussions with counterparts nationwide, exploring opportunities for regional collaboration.

Notably, they renewed a Memorandum of Understanding with Abadan University of Medical Sciences and initiated negotiations with the Arvand Free Zone Organization to facilitate patient admissions from Iraq. Additionally, they discussed expanding health services to patients from Bangladesh with a private company.

In a meeting with the Director of the Health Tourism Office at Iran's Ministry of Health, the SUMS delegation underscored the importance of transitioning International Patient Departments (IPD) in public hospitals to the private sector to enhance access for international patients.

They also stressed the need to issue IPD licenses to qualified medical laboratories and radiology centers in Shiraz, ensuring adherence to established standards.

Second Joint Event of Shahid Sadoughi University of Medical Sciences and Teuku Umar University in Indonesia



As part of the cooperation agreement between Shahid Sadoughi University of Medical Sciences and Teuku Umar University, the second joint webinar was held on February 9, 2025, organized by the International Relations Office of Shahid Sadoughi University.

The webinar, titled "Opportunities and Challenges of Continuing Education in Higher Education in Indonesia," was led by Dr. Firman Parlindungan, Associate Professor in the English Language and Culture Department and Head of the Curriculum and Language Development Center at Teuku Umar University.

During the session, Dr. Parlindungan provided an overview of Indonesia and its higher education system, followed by an in-depth discussion on the opportunities and challenges of studying at Teuku Umar University. The webinar concluded with a Q&A session, allowing participants to engage with the speaker and exchange information about the health faculties of both universities. Public Health, Nutrition, and Occupational Health are among the academic programs jointly offered by the two institutions.
